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Brief Description

The key element of the project involves settlement and habitat planning in the flood-affected Kosi region of Bihar, India, with a disaster risk reduction focus and setting up of rural hubs providing access to poor people who have lost their shelter by making available guidelines, technologies and more importantly material and choices for reconstruction of houses. The activities would involve:

Pilot Settlement Planning exercises; Rapid assessments conducted at the regional level for infrastructure, agriculture and water and sanitation planning/ reconstruction; A GIS database developed; Technical guidelines developed and training and capacity-building for hazard-safe construction conducted; District Management Support Cells (DMSCs) established to support District Magistrates in information management, implementation and monitoring, and reconstruction coordination; Cluster-level building and facilitation Hubs within affected Districts set up and upgraded to resource hubs; and Communities (especially women and marginalized groups) informed and empowered to access and influence their reconstruction needs.
